Do your slides:

- ...have a consistent format, font, and layout? ☐
- ...have one basic point per visual? ☐
- ...present figures as diagrams or graphs? ☐
- ...hide the identity of any patients? ☐
- ...have page numbers? ☐
- ...use simple fonts that are easy to read
(eg, Arial, Helvetica, Verdana, and Comic Sans)? ☐
- ...use no more than two font types per slide? ☐
- ...use lower case (not UPPER CASE)? ☐
- ...have no more than 6 lines of 6 words per slide? ☐
- ...contain no spelling mistakes (use a spell-check)? ☐
- ...make use of lists and bullet points? ☐
- ...use indents and bullets only one level down? ☐
- ...start with an “action” word and avoid full sentences? ☐
- ...avoid punctuation marks, unless it is a quote? ☐
- ...avoid irrelevant/personal images to fill spaces? ☐
- ...avoid unnecessary animation (slide transition, etc)? ☐
