Week 1—Introduction

Learning outcomes:

- · Become familiar with the virtual learning space
- Get to know each other and build trust

Tasks:

- 1. Get to know the virtual learning space
- 2. Introduce yourself in the introduction forum
- 3. Complete the precourse self-assessment (sent in a separate email, not in Desire to Learn)

Your first Task 1.1: Get to know the virtual learning space

Purpose: to become familiar with the virtual learning space and to understand its elements

Task: start by reading the "News" messages which are located in the center of the screen. Then have a look at the different features and functions of the learning space (discussion area, course builder, participant list etc.), if necessary consult the user guide.

Your second Task 1.2: Introduce yourself in the introduction forum

Purpose: to send your first message—visible to all participants

Task: spend a few moments thinking about what your first message will be and then click on Introduction. Open up the forum there and you will see a message to reply to. Good luck with posting your first message.

Respond: return to the introduction forum from time to time over the next few days and acknowledge your fellow participants' introduction messages.

Your third Task 1.3: Complete the precourse self-assessment

Purpose: for you to recognize where your gaps are, for us to prepare the live event according to your level of knowledge and gaps.

Task: please go to the assessment e-mail and open the link. You will be asked questions pertaining to the following:

- 1. What are your demographic details?
- 2. Your present and desired level of abilities
- 3. Two (2) knowledge questions per-competency

Please answer the questions and click the "DONE" button at the end. Your results will only be used in an overall report and not on an individual level.
